**NOTICE OF BUSSING AND MOVEMENT OF SENIOR HIGH FORM 2
& 3 STUDENTS FROM THE BOARDING HOUSE INTO ASAWASE
CONSTITUENCY-ASOKORE MAMPONG MUNICIPAL**

I write to complaint to your office the bussing of form 2 and form 3 Senior High School students into Asawase Constituency, to register during this on- going voter registration exercise.

Last week about thirty (30) students of the Asanteman Senior High School were bussed to two (2) polling stations or centres at ASABI- a suburb of the Asokore Mampong Municipal which makes up the Asawase Constituency. They were identified as **NOT** living, residing or hailing from any of the Asokore Mampong Municipal (Asawase Constituency) towns or communities and for that matter, the Asawase Constituency (*video and audio evidence to support this statement would be made available at your request*).

The students who were arrested and handed over to the police are;

1. JONAS AMOAH
2. SARFO EDMOND
3. AGYEMNG PRINCE
4. DUAH JEFFERY
5. ACHEAMPONG KOJO
6. FREDERICK OWUSU GIDEON and
7. AKOSU FRANCIS

The students alleged that one Mr. BISMARK FORDJOUR (aka anadwo) bussed them. The students were then taken to the Asanteman Senior High School as a follow up, to ascertain as to whether their claim of being students of the School was true or otherwise; a move that confirmed that they were certainly students of the school. Further checks also revealed that Mr. **BISMARK FORDJOUR (aka Anadwo)** is a tutor at the (Asanteman Senior High).

It is however important to note that the teacher could not be reached via phone contacts after several attempts.

In our quest to prevent instant justice and lynching of the students, our team handed them over to the Asokore Mampong District Police command.

This week starting from Monday another busing incidents occur at Parkuso another suburb of Asokore Mampong Municipal (Asawase Constituency) students from Osei Kyeretwie Secondary School being bused to polling stations to register when they do not reside there. Some of the students who are even minors are;

To our utmost shock and dismay, parents were authorised to send their wards to school (boarding house) and were denied visiting them; an attempt to protect them from getting exposed to COVID-19, following the President's directives. How then would teachers illegally bus 2nd and final year students to Asawase, for registration without the consent of their parents?


We are by this letter drawing your attention to the fact that, the teachers and all the bussed-students engaged in a criminal offence in contravention of section 27 of the Representation of People Law 1992 PNDCL 284; an added difficulty to their getting exposed to COVID-19.

We respectfully ask for your intervention in this matter, by preventing future occurrences which have the tendencies of putting the lives of our innocent 2nd and final year SHS students into a higher risk of contracting the disease (COVID-19) and/or being attacked physically.

We hope our complaints would be given the attention it requires, following your commitment to integrity and moral uprightness of students, teachers and the Ghana Education Service as a whole.
