The recent happenings at the GSL between the SRC and the school's management is distasteful, repugnant and an affront to student's governance. NUGS holds the position that the letter from the Management of the school dated 2nd February 2021 withdrawing recognition of Mr. Philemon Laar as SRC president and the subsequent withholding of SRC's funds amount to undue interference by the management in student's governance.

Such illegal directive and action by the management of the school is contrary to standard practices at all levels of student's governance. The unfortunate action amounts to abuse of power by management to suppress the will of students.
