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RE: MEDICAL REPORT: PERFECT AGBEKO, (39 YEARS)

Diagnosis: Brain Tumour

Patient is a seamstress of profession who is suffering from a brain tumour which is probably suspected to be benign (not cancerous) which has been progressing gradually until it is big enough to put pressure on normal brain tissue and hence the symptoms. It needs to be surgically removed as it is causing a severe sharp headache coupled with neck pain accompanied by double vision, seizures, speech disorder, weakness, numbness and electric shock sensations on the right side of the body. This makes her feel tired early easily.

This needs to be done to save her life. We need some surgical supplies that will help us repair all the tissues eroded by the tumour. Among the surgical supplies are materials to prevent and tackle bleeding, artificial brain covers, artificial bone cement, metallic implants to hold the fragment of bone and the skull together after the surgery.

Neuronavigator, Surgical Microscope and O-arm accessories will assure the accuracy of the location of the tumour and the safety of the surgery. All these needed items are disposable and will be purchased by the patient from independent suppliers outside our medical facility.

There will be hospital bills to be paid to Ridge Hospital. The amount cannot be predetermined but the hospital can give an estimate.

There are medications that the doctors will be prescribing before, during and after the surgery which need to be purchased. 10 units of blood need to be donated for him for the surgery.

These units of blood will be processed by the Ridge Hospital Blood Bank for a fee. Labs, x-ray and ECG will be done for anaesthesia clearance before surgery is programmed to take effect.

Some invoices and receipts of predictable costs are to be attached to this report.

After this, she will undergo physiotherapy to help her regain some lost functions of the brain. Radiation therapy might also be necessary if it is confirmed that the tumour is malignant. Updates on her condition could be made available upon request or when necessary.
