WATER SUPPLY INTERRUPTION TO THE KUMASI METROPOLIS

- The Management of Ghana Water Ltd (GWL), Ashanti Region, wishes to inform its cherished customers and the public that there has been a major burst on the 36" (900mm) transmission line that serves a greater part of the Kumasi metropolis. As a result, the Barekese Water Treatment plant and the Achiase Booster have been shutdown to enable repairs.
- The engineers of GWL are working assiduously to repair the line and resume operations as early as practicable.
- The transmission line was perforated by equipment of the contractor constructing drains from the Suame roundabout to Brehman Ahenful.
- The areas envisaged to be affected include Suame, Tafo/Pankrono, Asokwa, Bantama, Sokoban, Kronum, Barekese, Manhyia, Oforikrom, Kwadaso, Atasamanso, Kotwi, Adum, KNUST, Odoum, Asokore Mampong, and surrounding areas.
- Management assures the public that engineers are working around the clock to ensure repairs are completed as soon as practicable and supply will resume immediately works are completed.
