PRESS RELEASE

The West African Examinations Council wishes to inform its numerous stakeholders that it has released **provisional results** of 12,452 who sat for the West African Senior School Certificate Examination for Private Candidates, 2025 – First Series. The entry figure comprises 5,269 males and 7,998 females. A total of 738 candidates who registered for the examination were absent.

The Council detected some malpractices during the conduct of the examination and during the marking exercise. In view of that the subject results of 34 and the entire results of 43 candidates have been withheld pending the conclusion of investigations into the cases of malpractice.
